

CLEVELAND MAN HEAD OF RABBIS

Dr. Moses J. Gries, rabbi of the Temple, Central-av S. E., and E. 50th-st., was elected president of the Central Conference of American Rabbis at the concluding session of the organization's convention at Atlantic City, N. J., Tuesday. Dr. Kaufman Kohler of Cincinnati was elected honorary president.

Resolutions condemning secret fraternities in colleges and universities supported by public funds, and advocating the issuance of health certificates to those contemplating marriage were passed at the convention.

The conference will petition congress to aid in preventing disfranchisement of Roumanian Hebrews should the district of Sillistria be ceded to Bulgaria by Roumania.
