

PAY LAST HONOR TO RABBI GRIES

Hundreds Attend Outdoor Funeral Services.

Amid a downpour of rain and snow hundreds paid tribute to Rabbi Moses J. Gries when funeral services for him were held in front of the Hays mausoleum, Mayfield cemetery, yesterday afternoon.

Short services were conducted at the Gries home, 10311 Lake Shore boulevard, N. E., by Rabbi A. H. Silver, only immediate relatives attending on account of flu restrictions.

The pallbearers, all nephews of the rabbi, were W. G. Goldsmith, H. R. Dryfoos, Ralph Joseph, George Hudac, James Bach of East Orange, N. J., and Herman Moss.

Rabbi Gries died Wednesday. On retiring several years ago he had been pastor of The Temple, E. 55th street and Central avenue, S. E., for twenty-five years.
