The Tiffereth Israel Congregation Committee Decides to Call Rabbi Moses J. Gries.

Rabbi Moses J. Gries preached to the Tiffereth Israel congregation on Friday evening and Saturday and Sunday forenoons. The committee was so highly pleased with the efforts that at a meeting on Sunday evening it unanimously recommended that he be called to succeed Rabbi Hahn.

Rabbi Gries was born in Newark, N. J., is twenty-five years of age, and unmarried. He graduated from the Hebrew Union college, Cincinnati, where he was a student eight years. His first charge was in Chattanooga, Tenn., where he gave great satisfaction. Though yet a very young man, he has few ministerial superiors in learning and eloquence, and would be a worthy successor of Rabbi Hahn. The congregation will meet next Sunday forenoon and take official action on the committee's report.
